Invitation to apply for admission to the WSU Ph.D. program in accounting, taxation emphasis

The Hoops Institute of Taxation Research and Policy, and the Department of Accounting, Carson College of Business, Washington State University, Pullman, Washington, invite exceptionally qualified individuals to apply for admission to the Ph.D. program in accounting. Qualified candidates will demonstrate previous tax education, multiple years of professional tax experience, and an interest in pursuing a career of academic tax research. An accepted candidate will be eligible to apply for both a Hoops Graduate Fellowship in Accounting and for a graduate assistantship from the Carson College of Business and Washington State University. A WSU Carson College graduate assistantship includes a tuition waiver and a stipend, and this will be supplemented with special support to be provided by the endowment of the Howard D. and B. Phyllis Hoops Graduate Fellowships in Accounting. Total annual compensation during the course of a typical four-year Ph.D. program will likely be in the \$25,000-\$30,000 range, assuming consistent degree progress and satisfactory work required by the terms of the assistantship (approximately 20 hours per week).
