REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTREPRENEURSHIP MINOR
(2015 - 2016 academic year)

General Instructions:

A student may minor in entrepreneurship by completing 18 hours in the course work listed below, with an overall GPA of at least a 2.5 in the required courses.

Nine hours must be 300-400 level courses taken in residence at WSU or through WSU-approved education abroad or educational exchange courses. Up to 6 hours may be transferred from another institution, which is not calculated into your minor GPA. Students must ensure that they meet all course prerequisites before enrolling in any Carson College of Business courses. *Students cannot enroll in upper division Business courses until they have certified to the minor*

NO course for the Entrepreneurship minor may be taken on a pass/fail basis.

Students who are enrolled on the Pullman campus are not permitted to sign up for a distance courses.
